

It's a Puzzle Quilt

Cut:

14 – 5½" squares of one fabric for border

82 – 5½" squares of scrap fabric

Finished quilt will measure *approximately* 42" x 57".

For other size squares:

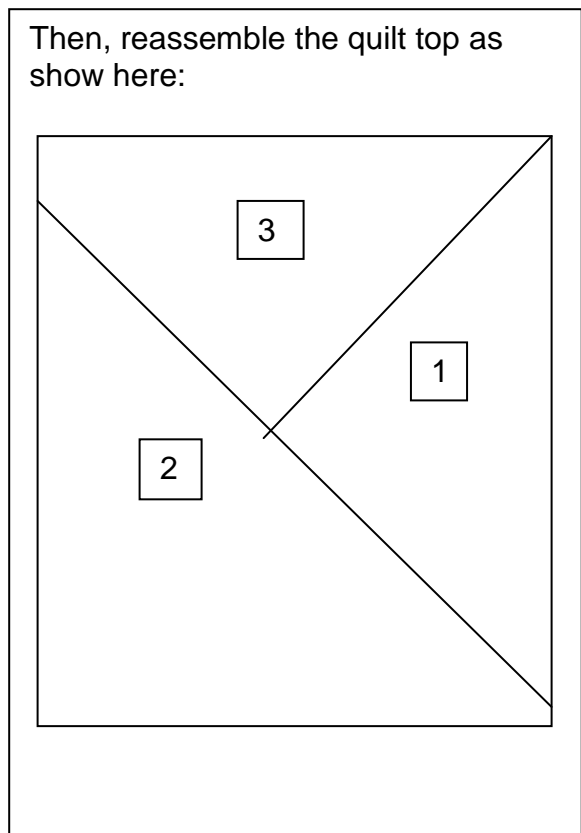
Cut squares	4"	4½"	5"	6"	6½"	7"
Width	30	34	38	47	51	55
Length	40	45	51	62	68	74

Sew scrap squares together in rows of 8 squares, using your border fabric squares as shown by the X's in this diagram.

Then, sew the rows together.

Cut the quilt top into 3 pieces diagonally through the X squares as shown.



To avoid duplicate squares next to each other, make sure the following pairs do not have the same fabric:

1H-9A	2H-10A	3H-11A	4H-12A	5H-1A	6H-2A	7H-3A	8H-4A	9H-5A
10H-6A	11H-7A	12A-1A	12B-1B	12C-1C	12D-1D	12E-1E	12F-1F	12G-1G
