

Opportunity Quilt Block

You are provided with a white triangle measuring 10.5" on each side.

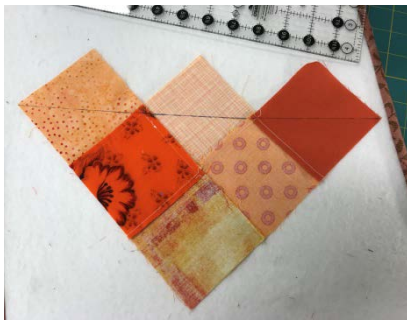
Select an assortment of prints in the color you signed up for. Variety is good, but do not use very light colors. Cut six 3.5" squares.

Sew them together as illustrated. (1)

Important step: Spray starch the pieced block and the white triangle provided before you continue, as you will be working with bias edges.

Working on the back, draw a stitching line through the diagonal as shown, being careful not to cut off any points. Only use pencil or Frixion pen to mark. (2)

Using your rotary cutter and a ruler that has a visible 1/4" seam mark, trim the block 1/4" away from stitching line. (3)

With right sides together, sew white triangle to your pieced triangle, being careful not to cut off points. There will be excessive seam allowance on white piece, but **DO NOT TRIM** your block.
