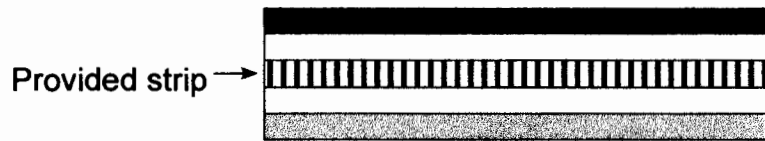
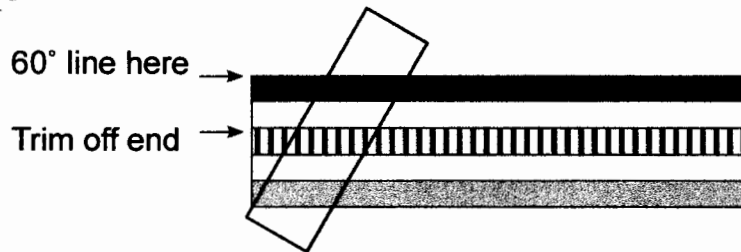


OWQ September 2017 BOM - Spiderweb Block - Cindi Jo Willey

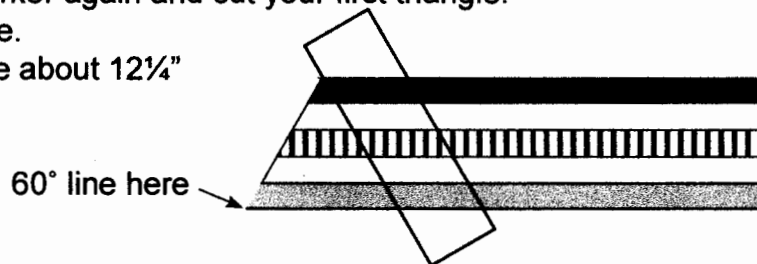
For this piece, you will need five 2½" x WOF strips. One strip is provided for you. Sew the strips together on the long sides, placing the provided strip in the center. Press all of the seam allowances in the same direction. (Doesn't matter which way)



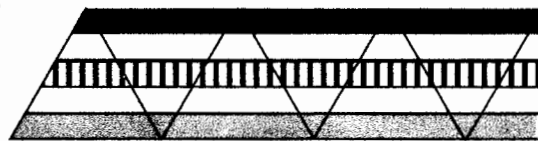
Line up the 60° marker on your ruler to the long outer edge. Place ruler so the edge lines up with the corner. Use your rotary cutter to trim off the end. **MAKE SURE IT'S THE 60° LINE!!!**



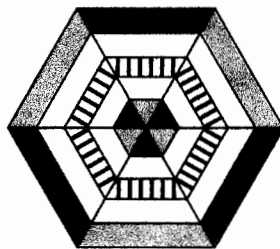
Flip ruler over, line up the 60° marker again and cut your first triangle. Flip ruler again to cut next triangle. The bottom edge should measure about 12¼"



Continue to cut six alternating up and down triangles.



Lay out triangles as shown. Alternating the up and down triangles.



Sew top three triangles together. Seam allowances will "lock" together. Start with left triangle to center, then add right. Press SA counterclockwise.



Sew bottom three triangles together. Seam allowances will "lock" together. Start with left triangle to center, then add right. Press SA counterclockwise.



Bring blocks to October's meeting with scraps. Winner(s) will sew halves together in rows, then sew the rows together to create the "webs".
