

Red, White and Blue Friendship Star

Finished size 9" Unfinished size 9-1/2"

You will need White-White (not ecru or not muslin), Medium-Red, Dark-Red, and Medium-Blue. Please feel free to use various prints. For instance your medium blue could also have little white stars, etc. Your white fabric could contain little bit of red or blue. Feel free to go out of the box and have a bit of fun in you fabric choices. Scrappy blocks are more interesting when made with a variety of scaled prints (not all solids). Just try to stay within the color scheme and color value.

Cutting And Prep:

cut @ 4"



Cut 1- 3-1/2" White square



Cut 1-3-1/2' Medium Blue square



Cut 1-3-7/8" Med. Red Cut 1-3-7/8" White

Make two half square triangles-They should measure 3-1/2". Square up if necessary.




Cut 1—3-7/8" Medium Blue Cut 1—3-7/8" Dark Red

Make two half square triangles-They should measure 3-1/2". Square up if necessary.



Cut 1-3-7/8" Medium Blue Cut 1-3-7/8" White





Cut 1-3-7/8" Dark Red Cut 1-3-7/8" Med. Red

Make two half square triangles-They should measure 3-1/2". You will only need one for the block! Square up if necessary.

This block is sewn as if sewing a nine patch. Lay out the pieces as shown.

Sew each row across. Roll or press seams open.

Then sew strips together. Press.

Your block should measure 9-1/2" unfinished.
