Approval of 2022-2023 Budget - Sharon L.

Per our bylaws, our membership needs to vote to approve the budget for the upcoming year. Below is a spreadsheet of the 2021-2022 budget and the recommended 2022-2023 budget as approved by the Board at their meeting on 5/31/2022.

While our expense is budgeted to exceed our income, our trend so far this fiscal year shows our income for dues and raffle baskets to outstrip what is currently budgeted. We anticipate that donations will also increase in the coming year, and it is possible that we might also find additional grant funding. Our bank balance is healthy, so absorbing the difference in expense versus income for the coming year will not be a hardship (although this is not something we can sustain for multiple years).

If you have questions about the budget or about the budget process, please let me know prior to our General Meeting on June 12 so you can feel comfortable voting.

DRESS A GIRL AROUND THE WORLD DRESSES - Ginny C.

As one of our many service activities we make dresses for a project led by Hope 4 Women International. This project aims to give every girl in 90 different countries around the world at least one new dress. There is fabric and other supplies available from the guild. Instructions/pattern can be found on our OWQ Website.

We need a new point person for this service. This volunteer will need to manage the fabric and supplies that the guild has for the project. The job will require that the dresses be collected and accumulated. Once 20 to 25 dresses are gathered, they are mailed off to the Hope 4 Women ambassador. Every month a record of the number of dresses mailed off needs to be reported to the chair of the service committee and a tally of dresses needs to be kept for the entire year. This annual total is reported at the appreciation luncheon usually held in March or April.

This is an easy job and is a great service for our guild as well as the greater international impact. Over the last 4 years I have done this job, I have sent off over 100 dresses in 4 or 5 mailings. So, you can tell this is not a position that involves a lot of time or effort. Please consider signing up for this position in our guild. Your participation will be greatly appreciated, and you'll get the added benefit of seeing all those cute little dresses that can really have a global effect.
