President's Message

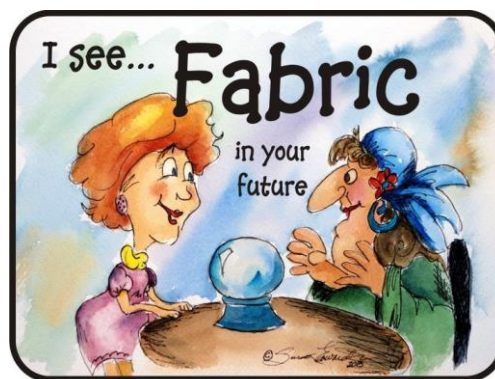
So long, farewell, auf weidersehen goodnight.....it is my time to go.....

The Kelly House Museum in Mendocino is having an exhibit on water towers this summer. My water tower quilt will be on display. The article is from Kelly House as well as a picture of my quilt.



A Water Tower Town

There are only a few more days to see the *Doin' a Little Doodlin'* exhibit and add your own napkin art to the Kelley House Collection. Next Thursday, the Kelley House Museum will open our summer exhibition: *Water Tower Wonderland*. The exhibit will explore some of the most iconic structures of the Mendocino skyline, both those deconstructed and those still standing, and will blend together history and art throughout.

Come to learn about the necessity and functions of the water towers and windpumps (fun fact: it is technically incorrect to call them windmills since in Mendocino they were used to pump water, not to mill anything). Appreciate the architectural beauty of the original structures in historic photographs, and see a model of the Kelley House's original, very fancy water tower.

The exhibit focus is also on the artistic potential of these magnificent structures: they have been providing inspiration to artists of all kinds for generations, and still do today. On display will be renderings of Mendocino water towers in several media, with serigraphs by Anne Kendall Foote and Bill Zacha, a quilt square by Dee G, and a woodcut by Emmy Lou Packard. The Kelley House has also been working closely with the Mendocino High School for this exhibit and will show pastels and architectural models made by students.

The exhibit will open on Tuesday, June 8th, and there will be a reception as a part of Second Saturday on June 10th. The Saturday reception will begin as a member-only event from 4:00–5:00 pm, when wine and cheese will be served. After 5:00 pm the reception is open to the public until 7 pm and we will serve cookies and soda. And water!

The Kelley House Museum is open from 11:00 AM to 3:00 PM Thursday through Monday. If you have a question for the curator, reach out to curator@kelleyhousemuseum.org to make an appointment. Walking tours of the historic district depart from the Kelley House regularly; for a tour schedule, visit www.kelleyhousemuseum.org.



QUILT SHOW QUILT DROP-OFF/CHECK-IN – Sharon L.

JUST A REMINDER FOR THOSE OF YOU ENTERING QUILTS IN THE SHOW:

DOUBLE-CHECK YOUR QUILT DIMENSIONS!! This information is key to how your quilt will hang at the show, and if you give us inaccurate dimensions, you create a significant problem!

QUILT SLEEVE: **ALL quilts** – regardless of size – must have a 4” wide sleeve **stitched** down (no pins, please) along the top and bottom of the sleeve on the back for hanging.

QUILT LABEL: All quilts must have the exhibitor’s name and address on the back. Please use the label attached to the entry form. Stitch or safety pin (pin at all corners) the label to the lower right corner on the back of the quilt. **Do not use straight pins.** Please bring your entry folded with the label showing. (Make sure your entry form and quilt label match.)

QUILT DROP-OFF: Quilts must be received at Sew ‘n Sew at 890 N. Franklin Street, Fort Bragg on Tuesday, June 20TH or Wednesday, June 21ST, **between the hours of 10 am and 2 pm.** (We are not staying until 4 pm!) Late entries will be refused. **We will be checking your quilt in this year, so please expect a short wait.** Your quilt receipt, label (if requested), show pin and show entry wristband will be given to you at that time.

QUILT RETURN: Quilts must be picked up on Sunday, June 25TH between 5:00 pm and 6:00 pm in the foyer of Dana Gray Elementary School. **NO QUILTS WILL BE RELEASED EARLY. NO EXCEPTIONS.** To avoid confusion and losses, no items will be released until all quilts have been taken down. No article will be released without presentation of a receipt signed by the recipient.
